Statement regarding impact of Covid-19:

On 03/04/2019 the trustees agreed a financial reserves statement: The trustees aim to ensure that the charity holds a level of financial reserves which will provide any necessary upfront costs for fundraising activities. This is judged to be between £1,000 and £2,000.

In September 2019, the Trust started a process to identify suitable projects which could be supported, in line with the Trust's Charitable Objects. Unfortunately, due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the final trustee meeting of the year had to be postponed and, consequently, this expenditure was not agreed. As a result, the Trust has committed very little expenditure in 2019/20 and our financial reserves significantly exceed our annual spending.

In the first quarter of 2020/21 trustees have agreed some expenditure which should have been allocated in the year ending March 2020:

Wellbeing project (counselling) Culture and Community Co-ordinator Design Technology Equipment £2,000 (agreed last year but not transferred) £1,200 £785 **£3,985**

If this had been allocated at the March meeting, the Trust's expenditure for 2019/20 would have been £5,335 with an end of year unrestricted balance of £5,138. These funds are allocated for spending as soon as is practicable in 2020/21.

Further projects will be discussed at the next meeting with an additional £4,000 allocated for immediate support. This will enable us to implement our agreed financial reserves statement.
